Summary Annual Report for the UNION PACIFIC RAILROAD EMPLOYES HEALTH SYSTEMS

This is the summary annual report for the UNION PACIFIC RAILROAD EMPLOYES HEALTH SYSTEMS, EIN 94-6001323, Plan number 501 for the period January 1, 2020 to December 31, 2020. The annual report has been filed with the Employee Benefits Security Administration, as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

Basic Financial Statement

The value of plan assets, after subtracting liabilities of the plan, was \$125,119,294 as of December 31, 2020, compared to \$119,811,410 as of January 1, 2020. During the plan year the plan experienced an increase or (decrease) in its net assets of \$5,307,884. This increase or (decrease) includes unrealized appreciation or depreciation in the value of plan assets; that is, the difference between the value of the plan's assets at the end of the year and the value of the assets at the beginning of the year or the cost of assets acquired during the year. During the plan year, the plan had total income of \$158,365,462 including employe r contributions of \$90,655,653, employee contributions of \$47,979,970, realized gains or (losses) of \$0 from the sale of assets, and earnings from investments of \$13,249,977.

Plan expenses were \$153,057,578. These expenses included \$12,156,778 in administrative expenses, \$140,900,800 in benefits paid to participants and beneficiaries, and \$0 in other expenses.
